| <p>The Uganda Human Rights Commission (UHRC)</p> | <p>The UHRC established the Directorate of Complaints, Investigations and Legal services (“CIL”) as a core Directorate, with two strategic objectives; namely to provide legal redress to victims of human rights violations/abuses and to provide legal advice to the Commission.</p> <p>1. Legal redress</p> <p>The Directorate carries out its mandate, through receipt, processing, investigation and resolution of complaints of human rights violations/abuses brought to the Commission by individuals and institutions, as well as those initiated by the Commission.
